Fashion Design 1

Create a dress you can actually wear! We'll learn the basic techniques of fashion design and then design a dress that you can actually wear. (We can have a matching one made for your favorite little friend for a little extra!) We'll have a few other surprise projects along the way!

Game Design 1 - Story Games

Move up to the next level of game design and program a scrolling video game. We'll guide you through learning a programing language to get you started and then you can use your imagination to create a game of your own!
